- Event was held March 2, 2023 (85+ attendees)
 - o Time I felt Safe: Working with familiar faces, leaders listening more than talking, appreciating and acknowledging all comments and feedback, agree to disagree
 - o Time I didn't feel safe: Toxic behaviors, foul comments, not respecting opinions, stealing credit, dismissing concerns, micro-managing, leaders questioning work and results provided by team members, lack of collaboration amount organizations
 - o Best Practices: Understanding the words "yes and no", using them appropriately, giving benefit of the doubt, respect is a two-way street, attitude can set the tone, celebrate mistakes/document lessons learned, embracing weakness
 - o After Thoughts: How can we normalize conversations surrounding career failures, how do we foster healthy psychological safety posture amongst CS and contractors and Ames.
 - Recommendations: How do we approve cohesive collaboration at the Center
 - o Leadership can improve communication throughout all the levels. Make sure contractor site management is engaging effectively across team members and boundaries

Public Policy- Sara Jain

- After weeks of political impasse, tense negotiations and mounting economic anxiety, the Senate gave final approval on Thursday night to bipartisan legislation suspending the debt limit and imposing new spending caps, sending it to President Biden and ending the possibility of a calamitous government default.
- Richard Branson's Virgin Galactic finally launched its first commercial SpaceShipTwo flight today.
 Galactic-01 took four Italians and two Americans across the threshold between air and space for a few minutes of weightlessness. Three of the Italians were mission specialists conducting microgravity experiments while the fourth was one of the pilots. The next commercial flight now is planned for August with monthly flights thereafter.
- ESA's Euclid spacecraft is on its way to the L2 Lagrange point where it will spend six years collecting
 data to help scientists understand the nature of dark energy and dark matter what some call
 the Dark Universe. Between them, they make up 95 percent of the universe, but scientists do not
 know any more than that and hope data from Euclid, NASA's upcoming Roman Space Telescope
 and ground-based telescopes will provide some answers.
